York County Soccer Hall of Fame Announces 2026 Inductee Taylor Parker McDowell

ROCK HILL, S.C. – The York County Soccer Hall of Fame announces Taylor Parker McDowell as a member of its 2026 induction class, recognizing her achievements as a player at the club, high school, collegiate and professional levels. Parker is the final individual to be inducted in 2026, a class whose contributions have significantly impacted the growth and success of soccer throughout York County and beyond.

McDowell developed as a standout player with Charlotte Soccer Club and the South Carolina Olympic Development Program, earning multiple state, regional, and showcase championships while competing among the Southeast's top youth players. At Fort Mill High School, she earned consecutive All-State honors, was named Region III Player of the Year in 2010, and served as team captain while collecting multiple MVP awards and recognition as a Gatorade Player of the Year finalist.

Collegiately, she competed at both the University of Kentucky and High Point University, where she earned NCAA All-Region honors, multiple First Team All-Big South selections, and team MVP recognition. Professionally, she played for the Carolina Cobras and scored the game-winning goal that advanced the club to the W League National Championship.
