York County Soccer Hall of Fame Announces 2026 Inductee Ellen Bright Borland

ROCK HILL, S.C. – The York County Soccer Hall of Fame announces Ellen Bright Borland as a member of its 2026 induction class, recognizing her accomplishments as a player, leader and coach throughout York County and the Southeast. Borland is the fourth of five individuals to be inducted in 2026, a class whose contributions have significantly impacted the growth and success of soccer throughout York County and beyond.

Borland developed through several top club programs, including Northside Soccer Club, Charlotte United Futbol Club, and Lake Norman Soccer Club, while also representing South Carolina through the Olympic Development Program. At Nation Ford High School, she earned multiple All-Region and All-State honors, was named Region Player of the Year in 2012, and competed in the North/South All-Star Game.

At the University of South Carolina Upstate, Borland served as team captain and established herself among the top goalkeepers in program history, ranking near the top in career saves, save percentage, and goals against average. She later continued her playing career in the WPSL and contributed as a goalkeeper coach at both the high school and collegiate camp levels.
