York County Soccer Hall of Fame Announces 2026 Inductee David Vance Benson II

ROCK HILL, S.C. – The York County Soccer Hall of Fame announces the induction of David Vance Benson II as part of its 2026 class. Benson is the first of five individuals to be inducted in 2026, a class whose contributions have significantly impacted the growth and success of soccer throughout York County and beyond. Benson's career reflects excellence in leadership, athletic achievement and academic success at the local, state, regional and national levels.

A standout at the University of South Carolina, Benson served as team captain during his senior season and helped lead the Gamecocks to a Conference USA Regular Season Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Across his collegiate career, he earned Coaches MVP honors, multiple academic recognitions, and contributed to teams that captured conference titles and advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

Prior to college, Benson starred at Northwestern High School, where he earned All-State honors, captained the inaugural North Carolina versus South Carolina All-Star match, and helped lead the Trojans to multiple deep postseason runs, including a state championship.
