Danielle Schmitt Russell to be inducted into the York County Soccer Hall of Fame Class of 2022

**York County, SC**—The York County Soccer Hall of Fame announced today Danielle Schmitt Russell has been selected to the class of 2020, which will be officially inducted into the Hall of Fame on August 25, 2022.

She grew up playing for Northside Soccer Club, played high school at Fort Mill, and went on to play collegiately for the Clemson Lady Tigers.

Danielle played four years at Fort Mill HS and was a four-time All-Region selection and All-state member her senior year. In her 4-year high school career, she scored 107 goals and recorded 35 assists. In addition, during her high school career she was a 4-year member of the SC ODP team. Danielle was one of the first female players from York County to play Division I ACC soccer (Clemson 2006-2009).

After graduating from Clemson, she continued to play soccer as an amateur and began coaching at her HS Alma mater and locally with Palmetto United, Charlotte United Soccer Club, and Charlotte Soccer Academy.

The York County Soccer Hall of Fame will hold it's dinner and induction ceremony Thursday, August 25 at the Courtyard Marriott at Kingsley in Ft. Mill, SC. There will be a cocktail hour starting at 6:00 PM followed by dinner at 6:45 with hall of fame induction speeches and Teams of Distinction recognition starting around 7:30 PM.
